**TREY SHIRLEY (-5)**

**Q. Trey, first of all, if we can get you to recap your final round, 1-under par 71.**

**TREY SHIRLEY:** Yeah, so I hit the ball pretty good today, just still really, really struggled on the greens today, just really struggled with the speed. The course is great, but just didn't really make anything. Hit the ball great, just never got the putts to drop to really get a good one going.

**Q. Just recap your week for us if you can.**

**TREY SHIRLEY:** Yeah, it was a lot of fun. Pretty blessed to be here at my first PGA, the Barbasol. Tons of family and friends come out. Was able to stay home, sleep in my own bed. It's everything I dreamed of and just really motivating to try to get back here to play with the guys. They're so good on this tour, so got some things I need to work on and we'll get back after it.

**Q. What did it show you this week to be able to maintain and make the cut here?**

**TREY SHIRLEY:** Yeah, just it proved to myself that I have the game to be here, I just need to tighten up little things. I'm normally a really, really good putter, but for some reason this week I just struggled reading the greens; maybe just where I put myself on the greens, stuff like that. We'll get to work on it. And I'm headed to Chicago right now after the round to get ready for the next tournament. It will a long night.

**Q. I was going to ask you if you'll continue to try to qualify for more tournaments.**

**TREY SHIRLEY:** Yeah, I haven't looked at the schedule yet. I've got full status on the Forme Tour. We start in Chicago, actually start on Tuesday, so I'll travel tonight, play a practice round tomorrow. I'll look at the schedule coming up and see if it works out with my schedule right now, but I haven't got anything planned out. Yeah, just really blessed to be here as well.

**Q. Were you at all slowing down as you got towards the end of this round hoping that it wouldn't end?**

**TREY SHIRLEY:** Yeah, a little bit. I enjoyed having all my friends and family out here. It's been pretty fun because on the road on the mini tours and stuff like that, it's kind of just you by yourself. So having a lot of fans out here, and the experience has been great.

**Q. And you saw the course early today. What can we expect this afternoon? A lot of**

**birdies still?**

**TREY SHIRLEY:** Yeah. The greens have got just a little bit more pace on them, I think they're rolling a little smoother today. Like I said, the grounds staff has done a phenomenal job with all the rain that they've had, but the greens were rolling great today. I think we'll see 7, 8, 9 unders again probably.
