



**BRIAN STUARD ( -8)**

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**Q. Brian, nice round out there this morning. Looked like the winds were pretty challenging out there?**

**BRIAN STUARD:** Yeah, a little less wind than yesterday afternoon obviously, but yeah, just a good solid round. Played nicely, drove it good, hit some nice iron shots, but felt like I putted really nice.

**Q. What's the key to playing this golf course well, do you think?**

**BRIAN STUARD:** I think you just have to drive it in play obviously and then kind of attack from there. The greens are pretty soft right now, and then you've got to make some putts.

**Q. As we wind down this season, your position's probably okay at 105, but as it winds down, do you do anything different? Do you have to focus on anything differently? What do you have to do and what do you do?**

**BRIAN STUARD:** I think right now for me it's just trying to get as much rest as possible. I've played a lot here kind of coming down the stretch, but got a few weeks to go, so just trying to stay fresh mentally more than anything.

**Q. Take us through the birdies, 10, 11, 12, three in a row there.**

**BRIAN STUARD:** Yeah, hit a nice drive on 10, good little wedge to maybe eight or nine feet, good putt. No. 11, hit a nice drive, hit a really good hybrid in there from 218, I think, and made a 15ish footer. Then 12, good drive and was able to hit 3-wood up on the green and then two-putt.
