Q. Adam, 4-under 66, you got off to a really good start today, which you needed. Just comment on your day.

Q. I know you talked about getting off to a good start and everything. Can you talk a little bit about the FedExCup and the Playoffs? You've never missed them. How much can you put that out of your mind?
