Q. Three under today, 7 under heading into the weekend. How'd today go?

So finding fairways is one of the crucial ingredients around this place.

Q. And first time back to Wyndham Championship in quite some years. What's it like? What's the course looking like, Sedgefield, from what you remember?

MATT KUCHAR: First time at Sedgefield for me. Last time I played was Forest Oaks, so I'm probably one of the few guys that have ever played Forest Oaks. I'm really enjoying this course. I think anytime you get a chance to play a Donald Ross course, a fan of golf wants to go play and this is certainly a fun course and I'm glad I'm here.

Q. Being 124 heading into the week, what was your mindset coming in?

MATT KUCHAR: I've never been one to look at numbers. I certainly know, we get texts every week with kind of your positioning on the FedExCup and I knew that 124th, I need to have a good week. Certainly, there's only so much I can control, but if I win, I know I'm guaranteed. But even outside of that, the guys around me, if they tend to play really well, I could find myself on the outside.

So I come in looking to just play good golf. It's kind of a typical week for me. You stand up on the first tee, you try to hit a good shot in the fairway and you go from there. I've always believed good golf kind of takes care of itself and I'm certainly hoping to put out some good golf and have that Top-125 behind me after this week.
