

TYLER McCUMBER (-12)

Q. Tyler, great playing, put yourself in a great position going into the final round. What's been the key for you so far this week?

TYLER McCUMBER: Yeah, obviously being sort of an old-school Donald Ross course, there's a lot of strategy here; being in the right parts of the fairway, angles. Definitely a thinker's course as well as executing it properly and I feel like I've been doing that pretty well.

Q. On a day like this, I know we caught a break at the end with the weather, but going in, you know it's going to be super hot. What changes for you preparation-wise?

TYLER McCUMBER: I'd say it would be more like the nutrition side, just really staying hydrated. Kind of consolidating your practice times, you know, just really saving energy because the heat takes it out of you.

Q. And then mentally is there kind of a way to avoid either getting more frustrated than normal or just constantly thinking about the heat when it's so hot? Do you have any tricks for that?

TYLER McCUMBER: I wasn't -- besides for a few jokes here and there with my caddie, Stone, I don't think we were talking too much about the heat today. It was a hot one. I'd say it was one of the hotter days I played because we didn't have a breeze really until the end and yesterday we had a breeze. Even though it's the same temperature, that makes all the difference in the world, so you get a little wind tomorrow.

Q. What is the hottest place you've ever played if it's not here?

TYLER McCUMBER: Puntacana. We've caught some hot days in the Dominican, yeah.

Q. So you had missed a bunch of cuts in a row. What do you attribute your good play this week to?

TYLER McCUMBER: Yeah, I've been playing great. Golf doesn't always give you the results you want. You've got to stay in the process and I feel like I've been doing that pretty well and getting rewarded for it through the first three rounds this week, so taking that momentum into tomorrow.

Q. Anything different that you've been trying to do or do you talk to your coach, your dad?

TYLER McCUMBER: No, just stuck to my normal recipe. Just finally got some momentum early in the week, making a couple putts, getting away with a couple misses and just riding that out and trying to stay sort of on that momentum train the rest of the week.
