SCOTT HEBERT: Yeah, to get under par, that really was what I was trying to do the last few holes. Wasn't very sharp today, but to make birdie on the last hole, my mom was watching via internet, so I told her I wanted to birdie the last hole for her and somehow I did it.

TOM GILLIS: Well, fly all the way back to south Florida tomorrow with the whole family and we've got a week off and then we're in St. Louis.
