CAMERON BECKMAN (-5)

Q. How was it when you went back out there?

CAMERON BECKMAN: You know, surprisingly it wasn't as wet as we thought it was going to be. The lies in the fairway weren't too bad. Normally we would have expected a lot of mud on the balls and it wasn't too bad.

Q. I got you through 10 when the suspension came on. You were done with 10?

CAMERON BECKMAN: Yeah, just a little tap-in on 11 and birdied the next.

Q. I was looking at your record this year. There's a little feast and famine there, some top-10s, you actually won, but there doesn't seem to be anything kind of in between. Is that --

CAMERON BECKMAN: You know, it's my first year out here so I'm working on trying to be more consistent, and the last couple weeks I've played really well and just didn't get much out of it, so hopefully I get a little more this week.

Q. Is there an adjustment to 54 holes as opposed to 72? Do you have to figure out what your mentality needs to be on Friday?

CAMERON BECKMAN: Yeah, the whole tour is like that, I think. It's a little different than playing the regular tour. It's a lot more fun, to be honest with you. I'm having a blast out here and just really enjoying it. Thankful to be 51 years old and playing golf.

Q. Any highlight shots out there?

CAMERON BECKMAN: I just made a lot of birdies, made some nice putts.

Q. How long were the putts on 14 and 15?

CAMERON BECKMAN: What's 14? Is that the par 3?

Q. Yeah.

CAMERON BECKMAN: I actually made about a 30-footer there. And then I just made some short ones coming in.
