Q. Danny, final round to finish at 15 under for the week, your thoughts on today's play?

DANNY LEE: Yeah, I had a very slow start beginning of the round. I parred the first three holes. Even 1 through 3 is very gettable, I was a little disappointed about that. I knew I needed some kind of a hot round to finish inside T-20 because I need -- I think I need like 43 points to get my card back. I'm playing through a minor medical, so I definitely did that. Then after I made a birdie on No. 10, it was just smooth ride. I keep making putts and kept hitting good shots. And eagle on the back nine par 5 was a bonus. The last hole was a disappointing bogey, but I got a good break and I had a clear shot with the -- kind of a so-so off the tee. Overall, it was a very good round.

Q. What is it about this place? You seem to play really good down here.

DANNY LEE: Yeah, it seems like you can't really allow yourself a foul ball here, so I think I'm more focused on the tee box. Even the second shots out here, if you miss the green it seems like it's very hard to make up-and-downs. So I think I'm focusing a little bit better.

And I've always playing with the very windy conditions where I grew up, so I think that's a little bit of an advantage for me. I like to hit a lot of different shaped shots and I think I'm very comfortable doing that. I think that's the only secret. Probably I can read the greens here a little bit better than most other events as well. Other than that, you've still got to go out there and play some good golf.
