Q. You played here, I think this is your ninth time. You've seen these golf courses in good conditions and bad. Would you rather have it like it is today or what do you think you're going to get tomorrow?

CHESSON HADLEY: I don't care how it is as long as I shoot 7 under. No, like it was great today. I haven't been playing that well and to take the variable out like the wind and hit some good shots the distances I want to hit them and then the putter woke up a little bit, it was great. But the Tour, they do the best job of setting up golf courses. It was -- because we're playing two golf courses, they had to set them up for tomorrow, not for today, because I think it's going to be pretty blustery tomorrow. The flags were a little bit more generous today because of what's coming tomorrow. I just was able to take advantage of some easier conditions and some more generous pin locations because of what's going on tomorrow, so hopefully I can just kind of keep it going.

Q. You mentioned your results in the fall. Do you feel like something has clicked this week or is it just golf?

CHESSON HADLEY: I still wouldn't say -- I mean I hit it great today, this is not a complaint or, you know, I'm just trying to keep it simple. The putter's been feeling great for a long time, so I'm just trying to give myself opportunities. And I was able to hit some great iron shots today and I put the ball in play, which I haven't done as well as I'd like, so it was a great start to the week, for sure.
