

ROUND 2 INTERVIEW

JOSH CREEL (-4)

Q. Josh, just talk about the overall conditions today. It was a different day than it was yesterday.

JOSH CREEL: Yeah, complete 180. Yesterday was about as easy golf conditions as you can get weather-wise. Both golf courses are in perfect condition, so if you get no wind and really good greens, the surfaces around the green, you can have some low scores. Today we had some wind and it was completely different. You get some of those sidehill, downwind, down grain putts and they're tough. We're grinding it out and we're happy to be playing the weekend.

Q. Poised to make your first cut and it comes at an important time. How much was that on your mind or how does it feel now?

JOSH CREEL: Yeah, I mean, obviously missing the first two cuts in the first two starts I got is not ideal, so we knew coming into this week that we needed to at least play four rounds and we're doing that. We'll peg it tomorrow and Sunday and see where we end up and see how it goes.

Q. Do you have a hard time keeping your emotions or managing your (no microphone) when those stakes are at stake and you're playing in tough conditions?

JOSH CREEL: I've been a little frustrated over the past month and a half. I've hit the ball as poor as I have in six months, so it's been frustrating and it's been a grind, for sure, but it is what it is, that's golf. We're going to keep swinging it and hopefully we'll come out of this funk tomorrow.

Q. And I believe you have a baby on the way, is that right?

JOSH CREEL: I do indeed. Colt Creel, due January 10th. Yeah, we're excited. A little nervous obviously, but it will be good.
