Q. John, just overall assessment on your round today.

JOHN HUH: Overall I made six birdies, which is good with this tough condition. I think the PGA TOUR officials did really well with the setting up of the golf course with it being this windy. Look forward to Seaside tomorrow.

Q. What was to you -- I mean, honestly, completely different conditions than yesterday, but what was the toughest thing for you to deal with the conditions over on the Plantation?

JOHN HUH: Just trying to get the right wind and hit the right shot at the right moment. I think I did pretty good today with my caddie and, like I said, tomorrow's going to be windy as well, but look forward to Seaside.

Q. What are you kind of seeing in your game kind of trending in this direction? Has it kind of been kind of moving in this direction where you saw these couple days kind of coming?

JOHN HUH: Yeah, I played really well at Mayakoba, which is really helpful. Didn't really have my game last week in Houston, but I put a little extra work this week coming this week. I think I did really well and hopefully I do as good as today yesterday.

Q. What were the things you really focused on coming in this week? Anything specific?

JOHN HUH: Just basic stuff, alignment, grip, make sure I shorten my swing a little bit, which I think is really helpful for me so I don't lose balance. Just like to stick with that next two days, it will be fun.
