LUKE LIST (-11)

Q. Nice way to finish there with four straight birdies. How would you kind of assess the way the day went?

LUKE LIST: Yeah, it was a tough day. Luckily it was similar wind to yesterday so we kind of knew what to expect that way. It's very challenging on the greens, so I was able to make some longer range putts. Missed a few short ones, but I know everybody's kind of dealing with that. so I tried to tell myself that if everybody's dealing with the challenges, then missing a few was okay.

Q. Did something kind of click on those last four holes?

LUKE LIST: No. My caddie and I had a good talk. I three-putted from like 15 feet on 13 and then kind of made an errant drive and missed a short recovery putt for par on 14. I knew I had a par-5 and some gettable holes coming in and caddie was really positive and said let's not worry about it, finish strong, and luckily that resonated.

Q. How difficult was putting? A couple of the guys had three-putts from close range with the wind and the high speed of the greens.

LUKE LIST: Well, the challenging is if you have a grain change. So if you have an into the grain and down grain and then the wind into you, it's just very difficult to judge because you have to play the wind because the green speeds are so fast. Pretty much any putt's challenging just getting the speed right. So fortunately I had a couple three-putts, but I'm sure a lot of people did too, so it happens.

Q. Denny McCarthy shot a 29 on the back today. You did quite well yourself. But to make that many putts on a day like this, is it more impressive than it would be on, for example, a Friday?

LUKE LIST: Yeah, I know Thursday the scores on Seaside were very, very strong and it's that type of golf course that it's meant to have wind. Fortunately, the last couple days did have wind to give it some teeth, which it has. I haven't seen the forecast tomorrow, but I expect a little bit of wind so that will be a challenge in itself.

Q. What will you do tonight, anything different that you're in contention? I assume it's the same routine.

LUKE LIST: Yeah, family's here, which is nice. My little boy, his first time, he's five months, and daughter, she's been to a bunch of tournaments. So it's our first time as a family, all four

of us, being at a tournament, so it's a lot of fun.
