



SEBASTIÁN MUÑOZ (-13)

Q. Just assess your round today.

SEBASTIAN MUNOZ: Really, really, I think really good. It wasn't easy. It was a little more gusty than I anticipated. I felt like I got off to a good start making three up-and-downs on tough holes, tough conditions, so felt really good. Felt like the putter -- I putted good. It's tough to putt with windy conditions, so I felt like I put a good round and we'll see what needs to be done for tomorrow.

Q. Is there a specific green where you felt the gusts more than another one maybe?

SEBASTIAN MUNOZ: Yeah, that's what I was talking to Jose. Like on 5 we were like right in the breath of it and that ball turned so much, but then on 6 it didn't move at all. It was like trying to find a happy medium. It was kind of like a guessing game a little bit.

Q. Do you know Talor at all from the Dallas area?

SEBASTIAN MUNOZ: Not from the Dallas area, but I've known him for the last four years. We've been paired a couple times, maybe four or five times, so we know each other pretty good.

Q. When you're three shots back, would you rather be like today, cold and windy, or a little bit friendlier, maybe like it was Thursday?

SEBASTIAN MUNOZ: I don't know. I mean, I haven't looked what it looks -- probably, I don't know, if it was up to me, maybe calm like the first day. I feel like I've still got another low one in me if things are going all the way, but if it's cold and windy we'll take it. Whatever it is, we'll try to do our best.

Q. How much did the three-putt on 12 affect your momentum?

SEBASTIAN MUNOZ: Yeah, I mean, it started on 11 missing that green from the fairway. I can't do that. Then again another guessing game with the putter didn't go in, but on 12 Talor gave me a good line and I just -- I just wanted to bury it like in front of him and I got a little greedy, got myself like a six-footer coming back and I missed it. So it was a little bit of a bummer, but I think I did a good job on 13 hitting a couple solid shots, and on 14 giving myself another chance, and on 15 making a two-putt birdie. So I think I did pretty good after making that mistake, so happy.

Q. Where are you staying this week and how are you filling the hours off the golf

course?

SEBASTIAN MUNOZ: It's great, I'm staying, once you leave the club, to the right. I don't know what area it is, in a condo. But really good. It's similar to a spot I stayed here in 2019 which I played great, so I feel like that's why I stay there.
