Q. How did that last birdie there on 18 change things for the day?

DANIEL BERGER: Yeah, it was a poor ball-striking day, a poor driving day, but I hung in there and I'm still in the golf tournament so that's the important thing after today.

Q. What was maybe kind of different from your swing yesterday to today?

DANIEL BERGER: I don't know. I just hit way more bad shots today than I did yesterday and I didn't make four birdies to start the day, so that always makes it tougher. But it was good to finish strong with a couple birdies coming down the stretch. Like I said, in a good position come tomorrow.

Q. What's the mindset you kind of bring to the course this weekend knowing that you're still right there in the tournament?

DANIEL BERGER: Well, I would like to see the condition a little tougher, hopefully some wind picking up, but you've got to make birdies when you're in the fairway and you've got to take advantage of the par 5s.
