

Q. Guys, really came on there down the stretch. How would you guys kind of characterize how the day went for you?

Q. Harris, when you made that eagle on 17, you were like, okay, we've got a chance going into 18?

HARRIS ENGLISH: Yeah, I knew we would probably be one back, we'd probably need to make birdie on 18. Didn't happen, but all you can ask for is giving yourself a chance. And like Kuch said, we didn't have our A-game today, I certainly didn't, but he kept me in it. We had a chance down the stretch and all in all it was a great week. Always fun playing with him and almost had a chance to make it a fourth win in the Shark Shootout, so we had a great time and hopefully can get another chance at it.

Q. Harris, you kind of talked about how you won here last year and that kind of helped catapult you to the season you had here. Do you feel like another great week like this for both you guys can help do that maybe going into 2022?

MATT KUCHAR: When you come here, golf is fun. I think when we kind of step back and reflect, I think all of us play our best when we're having fun. I think this event is a nice little steppingstone to really enjoying the game, really being in love with being inside the ropes and trying to execute golf shots. And we're -- hard to believe there's never an offseason, I think we've got two more weeks and then the season starts. This is almost kind of a bit of a spring training, kind of going back in action, what needs to be tightened up before the start of the year.

HARRIS ENGLISH: Yeah, the same. Always fun playing partner golf and got some great weather here in Naples. It's fun to have a competitive event to put some stuff in play and get ready. I mean, Kuch has the Father-Son next week, so another tournament he can have fun. Like he said, we've got a couple weeks off and then back at it. It's always fun to come here and can springboard into having a good 2022.

Q. Harris, this one's for you since Matt's got one more week of playing. What will you do the next two weeks to get ready for Maui?

HARRIS ENGLISH: Yeah, I'll take off next week and probably get back at it. I'm going to Palm Springs for probably five or six days before going to Maui and guaranteed good weather and good practice time to get back into it. I'm looking forward to getting back there and ready to defend.

Q. Matt, just for you, going into next week with your son on the bag this week and playing with him next week, what do you think this week kind of did for him maybe getting him ready to step inside the ropes with you and playing next week?

MATT KUCHAR: I think for me, it's so much fun as a father to be alongside my son, who happens to love golf and has asked for years to get on the bag, get inside the ropes and do it. Last year was a treat having such a great week with Harris and I and Cameron on the bag. I think he learns a lot of playing golf, a lot of the detail that goes into playing professional golf. He's just champing at the bit to actually play. He was practicing every night out here and can't wait for next week to roll around.

Q. What was it like with Kevin and Jason out there? Kevin was really on a roll there?

MATT KUCHAR: Yeah, that's a good call. That was impressive stuff. I think we counted it was seven in a row and he missed a five-footer for eight in a row and a par five for nine in a row. Trying to add it up. At one point as a competitor I wanted to say something to see if I could jinx it, but I figured we would let it go and to see how far. To go seven in a row was awesome. They combine to be a great team. Jason really turned it on kind of when Kevin finished with seven and Jason came on strong as could be. That was a tough duo.
