

CAMERON TRINGALE (-12)

Q. Solid playing out there, I know disappointing bogey to finish, but you've got to be really pleased with your golf as you get ready to head into the weekend, 12 under par?

CAMERON TRINGALE: For sure, solid day. No complaints, my game's right where I want it. I think the golf course is maybe a little more benign this year with the conditions than in the past, but 12 under at Torrey Pines, you're never knocking yourself. Yeah, it was a good start to the week.

Q. You've had some success here before. As you go into the weekend, what's the key for you and what do you have to do on the South course to keep yourself in contention?

CAMERON TRINGALE: Just drive it in the fairway, that's first out here. The rough is dicey. You can get a good lie, but basically if you keep it in the fairway you're going to give yourself chances. If you're not, it makes for a long day. I've been driving it pretty well for the most part and going to keep trusting that this weekend.

Q. You had a good round on the South course yesterday, good round on the North course. Is there pressure on you when you play the North to feel like you need to go low?

CAMERON TRINGALE: Not really. I mean, if you do, you bring it on yourself. But the bottom line is, for me, I'm just trying to shoot as good as I can each day and you expect probably a little lower score out there. Yeah, just don't get distracted with the outcome and keep hitting the shots and making the swings.

Q. Cameron, following up on that, which do you think was the better round, yesterday's 5 under on the South or today's 7 under on the North?

CAMERON TRINGALE: I think 5 under's probably less repeatable, so I'd take the South round as being a little better.

Q. What kind of things do you feel like you need to work on a little bit for tomorrow, or is it everything's clicking pretty well?

CAMERON TRINGALE: I don't really -- I'm not going to work on anything, I'm just going to rest. Yeah, I think the tools are there, it's just making sure they're ready to go tomorrow and taking it as it comes to me.
