**Q. Final round 66, talk about today. Put yourself in contention.**

**LUKE LIST:** Yeah, I got off to a good start on the front nine with those four birdies. I was kind of talking to my coach before the round about how the dynamic of this tour and the game has changed with people being so aggressive and making a ton of birdies each week now. so I kind of knew to have any sort of chance I needed a good round and to go out and get off to a good start really helped, and to kind of keep plugging, I made that one bogey on 17, but other than that I played really solid all day, so I was happy with that finish on 18.

**Q. Talk more about those birdies, especially today you've had multiple streaks this week and you've been --**

**LUKE LIST:** Yeah, I've worked really hard on my putting and that's kind of what's held me back over the years. To really dig deep and make some putts. Thursday I got off to a good start with the putter and held on Friday, and yesterday I had a couple three-putts but that happens on these greens. And then today I rolled it beautifully on the front nine and made a lot of quality strokes even on the back, so that's a part of my game I'm continuing to work on and I know it's going to keep getting better.

**Q. And mindset after 17 with the bounce-back birdie to finish it off?**

**LUKE LIST:** Yeah, that was just icing on the cake. It was nice to finish with a birdie, I knew that probably gives me a chance. if not, finishing one back. But just to make a putt on 18, that's all you can ask to do and to have the opportunity to make a putt on Sunday is always fun to do.

**Q. More golf to be played. You'll be watching this leaderboard?**

**LUKE LIST:** Yeah, Will's trying to get a win and there's a couple other guys up there that are great players. No. 18's gettable and 17's a tough wind, you've got to hit a really good shot on 16 to make birdie and 15's a tough hole, too. There's a couple tough holes, but obviously 18 is a birdie hole also, so anything can happen and I'm looking forward to seeing what happens myself.
