

MAX McGREEVY (-10)

Q. Max McGreevy, thanks for joining us. Eight-under 64, got to be pretty happy with that. Just talk about that round and what you might have done the best today.

MAX McGREEVY: Yeah, it was nice to just finally get off to a good start and kind of keep it going. Made a couple birdies early, nothing special. Then just kept giving myself chances, nothing out of the ordinary just was finally capitalizing on some good shots and actually making some of the putts and whatnot. Been a long time since I put a round like this together, so it feels good to kind of finally put 18 holes together and actually make some putts.

Q. With a couple top-20 finishes in I think you've had 10 starts this season, is that satisfying for you or did you expect more to start?

MAX McGREEVY: Probably expected more. I feel like I always expect a lot of myself, but I know there's learning curves with everything that you kind of start with and whatnot. So it was nice to get a couple good finishes there at the end of 2021, but been a frustrating '22 so far. My caddie Brett and I have really been working hard these last five days, six days just trying to get my swing. We found a couple of things that I think have led to this success these last two days and we're just going to keep working on that and keep giving ourselves some chances.

Q. You've won before on our tours. Does it feel like it's a natural progression for you to maybe get a W out here under your belt?

MAX McGREEVY: Definitely. I do think it takes me a second sometimes to maybe get acquainted with a new feeling. PGA TOUR's a big deal, it's something that I've kind of looked forward to playing my entire life and actually having the opportunity now, I'm kind of having to relish it a little bit because I'm so excited out here. Once I can kind of put those nerves to rest a little bit, which I have been able to with the amount of events I've played so far, I can just kind of feed off the past success of different tours and different wins that I've had and hopefully give myself a chance out here.

Q. A 64 today is your career low on the PGA TOUR and maybe the low round of the day today. Do you look at that as like a little notch in your belt or is that another record you've checked off on your progression?

MAX McGREEVY: Definitely. As much as you want to take a giant leap at the start, I'm definitely one to take a lot of steppingstones, for sure. This is just one of those in that direction that's just going to gain more confidence for myself and for my game and I'm

excited for the next steppingstone. Hopefully another low round tomorrow and keep building on those steppingstones and hopefully keep giving myself chances.

Q. You went to the University of Oklahoma, I think that's where Chris Gotterup went. Have you had some discussions this week?

MAX McGREEVY: Honestly, I didn't get to see him this week because he flew in so late on Wednesday coming from the event in Vegas, but I've gotten the chance to be around Chris a little bit in Norman, up in Oklahoma, and he's a gamer. He's really good. I haven't had the pleasure of playing with him yet, maybe we will this weekend at some point, but I'm excited to see him tomorrow on the range and kind of talk to him. I know Coach Hybl back home is excited that we're both playing well and he's taking advantage of this opportunity very well and he's a great player. He's able to do that and you're going to see his name a lot more.

Q. Finally, is this your first trip to Puerto Rico?

MAX McGREEVY: College events, yeah, we played over at Rio Mar always. It's been a lot of fun so far this week.
