Q. How was the experience like going to that first tee, playing a PGA Tour event for the first time and all the support you got around the course?

GREGORY ODOM, JR.: I loved it. Everybody came out here to support me and like all I can say is thank you and I enjoyed it out here.

Q. How about can you take us through your birdie on 13 there, the approach there and the putt, too?

GREGORY ODOM, JR.: I was hitting good shots today all day, but they were just getting unlucky. That hole just pretty standard, in the fairway, on the green and I made it.

Q. I don't know if you saw Steph Curry comment about how proud he is of you and your amazing talent. I don't know if you saw that and your reaction to that.
