ROUND 4 INTERVIEW May 8, 2022



KEEGAN BRADLEY (-6)

Q. Keegan, how would you assess the day?

KEEGAN BRADLEY: It was weird, I played -- I didn't play my best golf today. It was choppy and then I had a couple good stretches but I had a chance there at the end, so I'm proud of that aspect of it. But I'm pretty bummed, I felt pretty good about this one.

Q. When you made that putt on 16 to get within one, what was your mentality those last two holes?

KEEGAN BRADLEY: I figured par-par would be a pretty good score, but if you hit it in the fairway on 18 you've got a decent shot at making a three. I hit that drive okay on the last hole and it kind of just -- it comes a little bit further left in the bunker, I'm totally fine, but just wasn't my week to win.

Q. You said to Rex just a moment ago that when you're putting like this, the game is in a great place. What did you feel so good about with your putting this week?

KEEGAN BRADLEY: Well, when they go in is when I feel happy about it, and they were going. I'm happy with where my game is at, especially my putting. Jeez, if I can putt like this, I feel like I can do a lot of damage the rest of the year.

Q. What kind of -- I know you started working with Phil Kenyon late last year. What kind of confidence did he kind of build with your putting?

KEEGAN BRADLEY: I mean, he's helped me so much. Really all we focused on is reading the greens and I've been doing a little AimPoint and jeez, my stats have really improved. I'm happy with where that is. It's the best it's been since I've had the belly putter and it's not even close. So I feel like I can be even better than I was with that now with what I'm doing here.

Q. With where your game is, how strong it is, as we get towards the PGA soon, you've got to carry a ton of confidence going into this big part of the season?

KEEGAN BRADLEY: Yeah. Jeez, I played some really good golf on Friday and Saturday in the bad weather. I feel like I can -- if you can play well in those conditions on this course, I think you can pretty much do it anywhere.

Q. You said to Rex also you feel like this is some of the best golf you've played in your whole life. Why do you feel like that, because you've played some really good

golf obviously in the past?

KEEGAN BRADLEY: I just think my game is so much -- it's so well rounded now. I'm much more precise with where I'm hitting my shots and my distance control is night and day better since working with Darren May. I just feel if I keep putting myself in these positions, hopefully I'll convert one of them.
