Q. Matt, nice push there on the final day, how would you kind of characterize the round today?

MATTHEW FITZPATRICK: Solid. Yeah, yeah, just solid all around. I hit some really good solid shots and got myself out of position a couple of times, 14 and 15 there, but on the whole it was -- I felt pretty stress free. I didn't feel like I kind of hit it too bad and managed some putts as well, which is nice.

Q. We always talk about how you play tough golf courses, tough conditions well. Heading towards Southern Hills in a couple weeks. How do you feel your game's stacking up as we head into the season's second major?

MATTHEW FITZPATRICK: Yeah, I'm looking forward to it. I don't really know a lot about Southern Hills, to be honest. I don't think it will be similar to what we played this week unfortunately, I really like it here. I said a lot already this year, I think for me it's a very important factor playing golf courses that suit your game, whether it's me, whoever it is. To me it shows in my results this year. I've played well around golf courses that suit me. It's just about picking and choosing where those are and taking advantage of that.

Q. Is there something that you feel you need to tighten up a little bit before you get to Southern Hills or do you feel pretty satisfied?

MATTHEW FITZPATRICK: Yeah, everything's pretty solid. There's some bad ones with everything really, so it's kind of just a bit of everything, keep doing what we're doing and hopefully it will click. Yeah, I don't feel like it's far off.
