

ROUND 1 INTERVIEW

TOM LEWIS (-6)

Q. Tom, got off to a good start today, 6-under 66, no bogeys on the card. Just a few comments about the round?

TOM LEWIS: It was nice out there, conditions were perfect. It was very humid, very hot, but there was no wind. So this year's less rough than last year if I remember rightly, so I think there will be some low scores out there. It's really nice to go bogey-free. I think that's the first time all year I think I've done that, so to do it out here is great for me.

Q. Did the course hold up pretty well with the rain that fell yesterday?

TOM LEWIS: It did, yeah, I think it's fine. Like I think the course will get eaten up a little bit as the week goes on, especially this afternoon. The greens are soft, there's going to be a lot of pitch marks, but the course is in good condition. With us playing preferred lies is definitely going to help.

Q. And then last question, how does this -- I know your score is reflective that you like the course, but how does this course set up for your kind of game?

TOM LEWIS: I think if you can drive the ball well, get it in the fairways, you're going to give yourself a lot of opportunities because it's not a really long golf course. We play much longer golf courses out here, so it's one that I was able to hit inside, you know, 15 feet a few times and hole some good putts.
