**Q. Kevin, a final round 67 in the Barbasol Championship. Can you just give us your reflections on today, please?**

**KEVIN STREELMAN:** Man, I'm tired. I think we all are. I gave my all. Man, Trey and I just battled each other. He's one of my best friends out here so that was kind of fun as well. I'm frustrated I hit two incredible shots there into the last two holes and hit two good putts, one of them went, one of them didn't. So I'm frustrated, but I get to go home and see my family so that's a good thing. I've got my card locked up. I'll rest up for a few weeks probably before Detroit.

**Q. That was my next question 76th projected in the FedExCup standings. How much does that mean to you to have it locked up so early?**

**KEVIN STREELMAN:** It's something I'm pretty proud of in my career, I haven't lost my card in 15 years. This is now my 15th straight year, so I feel very blessed. It's been a lot of work and there's been a lot of great people that have helped me along the way. I saw my buddy Jake Thurm this week, he helped me out a ton. I went up to Pebble and saw Kevin Hansen and he was awesome, and Rob Rashell's always been my man back home in Phoenix. So them and Doc Suttie since I've grown up have just been huge parts of all of this. For me to be doing this at almost 44 years, I feel fortunate, but to shoot -- what'd I shoot, 24 under over four days? I've still got a little bit left in the tank.
