

TAYLOR MOORE (-13)

Q. Taylor, can you just talk about how you felt out there today? Had one of your best days out here so far.

TAYLOR MOORE: Yeah, got off to a really good start, just hit a bunch of greens early. I think I missed my first green on 11 and then missed it on 18, but ended up making that putt. I really missed a few putts early and was a little frustrated on the greens my front nine because I hit the ball so well and then got a few to go in coming in, which was good to see.

Q. I was going to say, what do you think changed on the second half for you out there that you were able to be a little bit more --

TAYLOR MOORE: Yeah, I think I just tried to keep being patient. I didn't want to get too frustrated I didn't have some putts go in because I was hitting the ball really good and hitting it to the right part of the greens to give myself some good looks. Really just tried to keep hitting good putts and tried to see them go in.

Q. Do you think yesterday the weather, the wind had an effect on you not being able to do as well as you did today?

TAYLOR MOORE: Yeah, it was a little bit tricky yesterday. On this back nine out here it swirls quite a bit so it bounces around. Just another day out here getting more comfortable and I think that was the difference.

Q. And then with what you did today, how good are you feeling going into tomorrow about where you could end up?

TAYLOR MOORE: Yeah, obviously my game's in a good spot. Excited to get after it tomorrow. Just another day and just going to try to keep my head down, do my deal and go about my business.

Q. Taylor, if you could, as a member of a particularly strong rookie class, right now in the top three on the leaderboard you've got you, Cameron Young and Taylor Pendrith leading, can you just speak to the strength of that class?

TAYLOR MOORE: Yeah, I think it's awesome. We had two years out there, basically a two-in-one season, 40-something events and I think that's why you're seeing such a strong class. Like you mentioned, Penty and Cameron Young and a buddy of mine, Davis Riley, are all having really good years and I think for us to go out and be in contention a lot and keep our cards is just a testament to how strong our class is.
