

JOOHYUNG KIM (-18)

Q. Tom, great playing today, a 9-under 63. Had a good look to set the course record, but you tied it. How would you assess your performance today after a great day?

JOOHYUNG KIM: Yeah, I played great. From tee to green I felt really solid. I was hitting the shots that I needed to and I made a lot of putts today as well. So definitely happy. No bogeys on the scorecard, just birdies and an eagle, so definitely pleased with it.

Q. Another week where you're going to finish in the top-10. How comfortable are you in that position on the leaderboard? You've now done it a couple times this season on the PGA Tour.

JOOHYUNG KIM: I definitely felt a lot more comfortable today I would say. I wasn't really looking at the leaderboards, I was just trying to play my own game and I knew if I played well, I give myself a chance, so I just go did that. And yes, it's definitely been a process, but definitely feeling more comfortable.

Q. And as I mentioned, you're expected with this finish to earn your PGA Tour card for next season. You mentioned it's a lifelong dream of yours to play on the PGA Tour. What does it mean?

JOOHYUNG KIM: It means everything. Every day I've played golf I thought about playing on the PGA Tour, it was nothing else. Today it could get a little emotional tonight, but it's definitely been a dream, it's been a road and hopefully next season I'll be out here full time.

Q. Could you just take us through that 18th hole? I know you didn't get to sink that putt, but what was that like for you? Were you nervous?

JOOHYUNG KIM: No, I felt really calm. It was a great read and I don't know how that missed, to be honest. It was a perfect putt, I hit it really good. I did not expect it to break that much. It was just inside the hole and just got away from me, but it was still a great putt.

Q. And I heard you mention over here that the 10th hole, the eagle, can you take me through that a little bit?

JOOHYUNG KIM: Yeah, I mean, it was a good yardage. It was a soft pitching wedge in the wind. I really thought myself that if I could hit a good shot, leave myself a good chance, and as soon as I hit it, it came out perfect. I saw it land, I didn't know it went in and I kind of turned over to put my club in the bag and everyone just went kind of crazy. Yeah, it was just one of those shots where you don't expect it, but it was a great shot.
