**Q. Can you comment on your round today?**

**CALLUM TARREN:** Yeah, it was pretty solid. I kind of knew from the outset after the disappointing round yesterday that I had the bit between my teeth just to go out there and shoot a good one. Fifteen today was my target, obviously fell short of that, but still a solid day.

**Q. Now, your season, missing the first eight cuts the year, you make the cut at Honda and then the next week you finish in the top-5 at Puerto Rico. Right now you're projected to move about 106th as it stands at this moment in the eligibility standings. Can you kind of take us through your season, overcoming the start that you had and putting yourself, I don't want to say clinching a spot in the Playoffs at this point, but putting yourself in a great spot with one week remaining?**

**CALLUM TARREN:** Yeah, it was a tough start. I mean, missing eight cuts in a row, which I've never done in my life, especially when you get to the PGA Tour, sucks. But I wasn't playing bad golf, it was just one thing or another wouldn't go my way. Miss a cut by one or two strokes every week for eight weeks kind of grinds down on you.

But like you say, I stayed positive. I've got a great guy on the bag in Ryan and he kept saying to me, one of these weeks, just keep plugging along, just keep plugging along, and that's what I've done. And to finish the season like I am at the moment, I knew it was in me, but it being in you and then doing it are two different things. It's just nice to put some results on the board. And obviously I think -- well, someone's told me I'm good for the Playoffs. Yeah, I'm over the moon excited and relieved really. Yeah, I'm happy.

**Q. And lastly, the strength of this rookie class on the PGA Tour. You're one of a bunch that's going to be in the Playoffs, guys contending almost every single week, only Chad with the win but just week in and week out, how strong a rookie class is this that you're a part of?**

**CALLUM TARREN:** Yeah, I think it's a testament to the Korn Ferry Tour. There's probably a new rookie class coming up very shortly that's stronger if not -- as strong if not stronger than the one that just graduated. But I do think my graduation class, there's so many good players in there. But it's a testament to the Korn Ferry Tour as well. I mean, it keeps proving and providing new stars almost. Yeah, I'm just happy that I'm one of those guys who's managed to make the Playoffs and I really hope I can push on these next couple of weeks and get the best possible outcome of my season after that horrendous start.
