ROUND 4 INTERVIEW JULY 31, 2022



WILL ZALATORIS (-13)

Q. Will, congratulations, awesome finish today with a 65. What was different today from the other days?

WILL ZALATORIS: You know, unfortunately, not much, I just didn't get much out of the rounds the first couple days. I've been driving it amazing. Troy Denton and I spent a lot of time working on the driver after The Open Championship. I really didn't particularly drive it well in Scotland. It was nice to see everything click today.

Q. Following along, you've had obviously runner-up finishes in three of the last four majors. You've got to feel like you're grinding out and you're really close to breaking through and taking home major hardware.

WILL ZALATORIS: No, for sure. I'd pay a lot of money for about an inch and a half, that's for sure. We'd have at least one trophy by now. We're close, we've just got to keep doing what we're doing and that first one's gonna come.

Q. You like playing a busy schedule, I understand you're playing next week, you're going to be in the FedExCup and of course the Presidents Cup. You must like playing a lot of golf all the time to keep yourself extra sharp to get that breakthrough?

WILL ZALATORIS: Yeah, I'm 25, so if you hear me say I'm tired, I probably need to get my head checked. Yeah, next week it's kind of a home game in some respects considering I went to Wake Forest and obviously this is kind of the stretch of the season you prepare for, playing five in a row to end the season. Like I said, I'm young, I can handle it.

Q. One final question, is there one thing you think you're away from getting through on that breakthrough where you're going to start winning more and that kind of thing or are you already doing it, just got to keep doing it?

WILL ZALATORIS: Keep playing rounds like today and having everything click. I've kind of been -- my good tournaments I've basically played 54 good holes and I need to play just a little bit better than that. Just keep doing what we're doing. The good is there, just need to do it more often.

Q. On this tour 54 is great, but 72's even better?

WILL ZALATORIS: Yes. I've been very close obviously over the last little while and, like I said, we just need to keep doing what we're doing and it will come.



Q. Going into next week, looks like you might be right outside the Top-10 going into the final event of the regular season. How important is it to you to finish in the Comcast Business Tour Top-10?

WILL ZALATORIS: Playing for the FedExCup, so that's just part of it. The reason why we have that is obviously because we've got -- the way how it works at East Lake, the guys should be rewarded with how they play on the regular season and guys should be rewarded how they play in the postseason. Just keep doing what I'm doing. It's nice to have a chance to be in that Top-10, but I've got bigger fish to fry.

Q. And lastly, your friend Cameron in contention again, four strokes back going into the final round. What do you think about his chances today?

WILL ZALATORIS: It's like my brother, so I want him to go do it. He's been playing some really good golf. That 63 or whatever he shot on Friday was clinical. He's playing some nice golf and his time's coming and I hope it's today.
