Q. J.J. first of all, excellent final round, 7-under 65. If we can get some comments on your day.

J.J. SPAUN: Yeah, it was a fun day literally. Played with Kurt. Kurt's my good buddy out here, so we hang out a lot off the course. We talked about going to birdie-ville or birdie-town, whatever you want to -- whatever you want it to say out there all day. It was a very good mood all day and we had fun.

Q. Based on your finish right now, you're expected to move inside the top-30 in FedExCup standings. How important is qualifying for the TOUR Championship for you with only one week left in the regular season?

J.J. SPAUN: Yeah, it's obviously my new goal. Kind of had to adjust my goals after Valero, and first you kind of go from trying to keep your card but you're obviously still trying to win every week, but after winning it was like OK, now what. I kind of got caught in limbo for a few weeks, just not sure, still like a honeymoon hangover kind of thing where you kind of accomplished your goal of winning. And now that I've adjusted goals and set goals, that's the next step is getting inside the top-30 to make it to the TOUR Championship and getting in all those majors and all those big events next year on Tour.

Q. 66-65 the last two days, was there something you found in your game on the weekend that you didn't have the first two days?

J.J. SPAUN: Yeah, I hit it a lot better and drove it a little better. Actually, I drove it well all week, but I just stopped thinking about my golf swing so much. Like ever since I got back from a break after the Masters, I was kind of trying to not find my swing again, but just kind of lost all the feels that I was kind of rolling with earlier in the year. So that kind of threw me for a loop trying to tinker -- not tinker, but just trying to get it back to the way I was swinging early April, March. It's nice to just like free it up. I just stopped caring about -- thinking about positions in my golf swing. I mean, no one really plays great doing that anyway. I'm glad I did because it obviously worked out on the weekend.
