

JOHN HUH (-9)

Q. John, what was the biggest thing that you had going for you today?

JOHN HUH: Well, I think I hit it close enough, gave myself a chance. The longest putt I think I made was a 15-, 20-footer for eagle, but other than that, I put it pretty much inside 10 feet and made all that.

Q. Are you kind of surprised there's no one closer to you or did you look at the board?

JOHN HUH: I'm actually surprised I'm at the top of the leaderboard, yeah, to be quite honest with you. I didn't really feel my game was there, but it's one of those days where I took advantage of some good shots and good breaks, I think.

Q. (Inaudible.) You've been out here long enough, does that make you play better? Does it have any more pressure to you?

JOHN HUH: I think a little bit of both because I know what's on the line, I know how important this tournament would be. At the same time you've just got to go and play and I think I did that really well today.

Q. The rough out here is pretty challenging. I thought you showed your patience there on 18, you drove it in the left rough. Were you just trying to make sure you left it below the green with that second?

JOHN HUH: I was just making sure I hit it over the first bunker that I saw, which is the 170, and I was able to do it and I got lucky, that's all I can say.

Q. You shoot 61 out there. Are there any particular parts to this golf course today players have got to be careful?

JOHN HUH: There's a few holes out there you've got to be careful, but like I say, I took advantage of the morning wave and hopefully it doesn't really do (inaudible.)

Q. Just kind of highlight the eagle and especially that birdie stretch you had.

JOHN HUH: I didn't know it was a 38-footer, but anyway, I knew it was going to be a quick one. I hit a good stroke, hit my line. I was hoping to go and I got lucky that it hit the flagstick and went in the hole. It was just one of those holes where you hit your spot and hopefully it goes in.

Q. Career-low round for you, what's it like to have one of those days out on the golf course?

JOHN HUH: It's kind of strange because like earlier I mentioned, I wasn't really felt great with my game and shoot my career low, it's kind of weird. Sort of mixed feeling, but I'll take this any day. I was able to take advantage of a good break and good shots, that's all I can say today.
