J.T. POSTON (-4)

Q. J.T., a 66, nice start. If we can get some comments on your day.

J.T. POSTON: Yeah, it was a solid round of golf considering the way I hit it. I didn't really feel like I drove it that well. Hit some good iron shots on the par 3s to give myself some good birdie chances, but for the most part it felt like it was a grind and really got a lot out of it.

Q. Since winning, you haven't had the results here I know that you want, so how good does it feel to get off to a good start?

J.T. POSTON: It feels good. I think the hurdle I kind of had to get over was the way I won '19 was pretty much playing perfect golf, no bogeys. I think I just put too much pressure in the years after trying to come out and be too perfect. Today was a great way to kind of get the week started not only because of the score, but I really didn't hit it that great, so to actually shoot a decent score and be in a good spot to start the week is good.
