

ROUND 2 INTERVIEW

MARTIN TRAINER (-6)

Q. Martin, back-to-back 67s, if we could just get an opening comment on how the first two rounds have gone for you.

MARTIN TRAINER: Overall I think I played pretty well, kept it in the fairway, on the green, made some putts. This is a course I haven't really done well at in the past, so now that I'm playing a little bit better, I kind of surprised myself with how well I ended up playing, putting especially.

Q. You said you surprised yourself. Knowing you needed a big week, what were your expectations coming into the week?

MARTIN TRAINER: I mean, every time I tee it up I try to do well, so I think this is not any different. I mean, obviously I know what's at stake, I'm trying to get in the Top-125, so I'm just going out there and doing my best.

Q. What was your mindset coming in? You were 0-3 in making the cut here. Just in terms of this golf course, does it suit you or what's been the issue in the past compared to this week?

MARTIN TRAINER: When you don't play well, no course suits you, so I knew that coming in, that I hadn't played well here. But I had been playing well prior to this week, so I thought if I could just make a few putts, then I would have a chance and that's what's happened so far.

Q. Martin, are you someone that over the weekend will keep an eye on where things are as far as the standings go or will you just kind of go ahead, play your game and see where things end up in the end?

MARTIN TRAINER: Yeah, I'll definitely keep an eye on the leaderboard, but I know what's at stake, it's no different than any other week. I mean, I think ultimately I know that I just need to do well. Every time I play a Tour event I'm trying my best anyway, so I'll just look at it as a curiosity, but ultimately it's out of my control, so to speak. I'm just trying my best.
