

**ROUND 3 INTERVIEW**  
**August 7, 2022**



**JOOHYUNG KIM (-11)**

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**Q. After the end of play yesterday, where did you leave your spot on, when did you come back this morning to finish?**

**JOOHYUNG KIM:** Well, I finished on 11 yesterday, left myself a really tester and first -- especially kind of it would be ideal if you had a good spot and then kind of slept overnight, but it wasn't -- it was kind of stressful a little bit just knowing that I needed to get up and down just to stay in it, especially with hard holes coming up, and that's exactly what I did. I had a good two-putt and I could have made a couple more birdies it felt like, but I still finished back on even par and just puts me in a decent spot for the final round.

**Q. And putting yourself into the final round, kind of what's the mindset, is there a certain number kind of chasing after for today?**

**JOOHYUNG KIM:** I mean, just kind of take what I can, just be aggressive when I can and sometimes if you can't, just, you know, just play safe, play within myself, not look at the leaderboard too much, just play my own game and I feel like that's all I can do.

**Q. An early morning start, sun's coming up, battling sun probably, a lot of holes today, fatigue, how do you kind of factor in all those components?**

**JOOHYUNG KIM:** Yeah, I'm going to play a lot of holes today, but I'm still having fun out here so I feel like that's the energy that I have. I'm really looking forward to the final round.

**Q. Only a few hours until you tee off. What are you going to be doing between those hours?**

**JOOHYUNG KIM:** Take a shower, eat lunch and then warm up a little bit and get ready to go.
