Q. Brandon, I don't think you've been in front of this camera since your hole-out yesterday right before the delay. Can you walk us through that shot?

BRANDON WU: Yeah, I think if I remember, I was -- I played OK on the front but couldn't get it going. Then I made a nice birdie on 10 and we could hear the thunder rumbling, so we figured try to get a few more holes in.

But yeah, I hit a nice drive. It was kind of a perfect number and yeah, I hit it and it was trickling and waiting for the crowd to react and they finally exclaimed that it went in. So that was pretty awesome right before the horn blew, so that was great to kind of get the round back on track and yeah, some momentum as well.

Q. You mentioned the birdie on 10, eagle on 11. How difficult was it to sit through that delay when you were obviously playing well right before it and then wait to come out again until today?

BRANDON WU: It was kind of bizarre because we almost restarted in the afternoon as well. It is what it is. Like I think everyone's dealing with delays and stopping and starting, but yeah, felt good to end on an eagle.

Q. And last one, just your mindset going into the final round two shots back of the lead?

BRANDON WU: Yeah, just play solid. I feel like I've played really well this entire week and I've done everything how I wanted to, so I think that's still the game plan this afternoon.
