
Q. You've played TPC Southwind previously, but just your overall assessment on the golf course this week?

TYRRELL HATTON: Yeah, I think it's held up pretty well with the amount of rain that we've had the last few days. The greenkeepers have done a pretty good job to make it as playable as it is. Obviously we had to play pick and place today. Even if you hit in the fairway you're still going to have mud on the ball.

But yeah, happy with how I played today. Nice to get off to a decent start and feel like I continued a little bit of momentum where we left off at Wyndham last week. Yeah, happy with 5 under.

Q. Clean card. What was the key to your game today, in your opinion?

TYRRELL HATTON: Everything was pretty solid, to be honest. I generally drove the ball pretty good. I was in the fairway most of the day, which allowed me I guess to be a little bit more aggressive on some shots into the greens. And it was nice to hole a few putts early on. I don't feel like I actually holed that many last week even though I was hitting good putts, so it was nice to get off to a start there where I holed a couple early on, which kind of allowed me to have a little bit more patience than maybe I normally would. So yeah, as I say, everything worked pretty nicely, so hopefully that continues.

Q. And game plan going for tomorrow?

TYRRELL HATTON: Hopefully, more of the same. It would be nice to obviously get out there tomorrow afternoon and start in a similar fashion with just fairways and greens and giving yourself opportunities to make birdies. The greens are rolling pretty nice, so they're only going to pick up speed throughout the week. Yeah, hopefully I'm able to give myself some chances and we can hole some putts.

Q. Are you handling the Memphis heat all right?

TYRRELL HATTON: After last week this doesn't seem as brutal. Last week was absolutely roasting. I think the forecast is meant to get -- it's going to be pretty warm over the next few days, so that will present its own challenges. Should be good.
