TREY MULLINAX (-11)

Q. Trey, decent week and ultimately you got the job done, what you came here to do and that's get to BMW next week. Just your thoughts on advancing?

TREY MULLINAX: Great week. I didn't have my best stuff today on the greens or off the tee and that's not a good combo at this place. I did a great job of managing myself today. Made birdies on holes that I could have and didn't make any big numbers and that was huge this week. On 18 I hit a great chip shot to even have a chance to make a par, so job done. A little disappointed how I played today. I learned a lot about myself though, some tendencies I have to work on. All in all, a great week.

Q. How much scoreboard watching was there from a Top-70 standpoint and once you got within a stroke or two of the lead the actual tournament itself?

TREY MULLINAX: Not a ton because, I mean, Will was playing so good, I was just trying to keep up. I wasn't hitting it great. I was trying to scramble all day and when I hit good shots off the tee, I gave myself good looks. The putter on the front nine, I got behind the eight-ball early. Made a run there on the back nine early beginning with three birdies and the three-putt on 15 kind of knocked the wind out of our sails a little bit. Hey, it's a learning experience. Grateful to be where I am and I'm looking forward to next week.

Q. One of the shots that I wanted to ask you about when I first saw it, your second at 5, hooking it around that tree from I think 192?

TREY MULLINAX: Yeah.

Q. Early in the round when you have the pressure of the Top-70 kind of beating at you already, what kind of goes through your mind when you have a shot like that?

TREY MULLINAX: We were just managing. It really wasn't a hook, just the lie kind of made it hook over there. It was a 7-iron. We were going to open the face, try to get it up and let it shoot, so it did. We were in scrambling mode for a long time today. My caddie, Jules, and I, I thought we did a really good job of not making any big numbers, staying patient, staying with it. I'm disappointed how I finished, but like I said, it's a learning experience. I understand some of the things I do now and I'll be better for it.

Q. Are you relieved it's over for this week?

TREY MULLINAX: Yeah and no. Like I said, I'm disappointed that I finished the way I did. I felt I had a chance to maybe make a run there on the back nine, but like I said, not a disappointing week.
