BERNHARD LANGER (-6)



Q. Bernhard, good round today, 5-under 67. If we could just kind of have you give some thoughts on the round.

BERNHARD LANGER: Yeah, got off to a wonderful start, birdied the first three holes. Hit it good, hit it pretty close but made some putts. It was nice to see a few going in, especially yesterday I played pretty good but didn't make much at all and had 17 pars and one birdie yesterday, so it was good to get a few birdies early. Played fairly solid for most of the day. I think I got one bogey in there somewhere, but the rest of the day was pretty good. Yeah, could have made one or two more birdies. No. 18 I left it like this much short online and 17 went over the lip, 16 went over the lip. I was knocking on the door.

Q. Six under through 36 holes, just some thoughts on the course here. I imagine you've got a pretty rich history here at En-Joie going back to the B.C. Open days.

BERNHARD LANGER: I didn't play the B.C. Open. Yeah, that's the time of the year when I played in Europe usually. Enjoyed coming back here the last whatever, 12, 14, 15 years, I've been out here that long. It's one of the favorite stops. It's great how the community supports the tournament and Dick's is a fantastic sponsor. The golf course hasn't changed a bit and doesn't need to. Players love it and it's a great event.

Q. A bigger crowd out there today. What can you talk about kind of the environment that the fans brought?

BERNHARD LANGER: Yeah, it's wonderful to see a lot of people out. The forecast was pretty good yesterday and today, which helps, and yesterday they had the big show going on on the 18th, so that always brings a lot of people out later in the afternoon.
