Q. Jim, 4-under 68 today capping off your first tournament back in quite a while. Just kind of assess how you felt.

JIM FURYK: You know, I'm still not -- I still don't have a ton of energy. I actually rode this week, first time I've ever done it, but I feel pretty good. Happy with the way I played. I think it's my best finish of the season so far, so to kind of have that much time off and then come back and play that well is a lot of fun.

There's still some things I want to work on in my game, but excited to play well here at Dick's and I love the course at Warwick Hills next week at Ally, so excited to kind of get there and hopefully carry some of this momentum into next week.

Q. You kind of mentioned yesterday talking about how this is one of the more narrow courses and really having to kind of hit the fairways and obviously you came up with some really good birdie putts, but just how did you feel in terms of consistency third day kind of managing the course?

JIM FURYK: You know, I probably drove the ball a little better on Friday and Saturday, but I did a good job this week -- I think that's one of the weaknesses this year. Usually hitting fairways is one of my strengths. I've been driving the ball poorly this year. Put a new driver in play this week, I've been working with it at home for the last couple weeks. I was very comfortable with it and it was nice to hit some good drives down the stretch under some pressure. No. 18's always a tough drive. So I kind of -- golf course was very similar today. Obviously the rain, kind of the weather, heard some rumbles out there, hoping that we wouldn't be delayed. We all want to kind of finish and get on a plane and get to the next spot or get home for me. I'm happy with the day and I was happy with the way I kind of got it around and scored.
