

**STEVE FLESCH ( -5)**

**Q. Steve, off to a great start, 5-under 67, coming off a good finish here last year. Just a few thoughts on the course and how you're feeling like it suits well for your game?**

**STEVE FLESCH:** They made a lot of changes to it. It's playing much more different than last year, it's a lot firmer, faster, greens are tough to get the ball close on this year. Seems like the run-offs are a little more severe than they were. It kind of suits my conservative style of play. Never been a guy who kind of aims at a lot of flags and here it's hard to get the ball on the green sometimes. Drove it well, made some great putts and it added up to a great score.

**Q. Double beach, a little bit different than Timuquana Country Club. You're obviously playing some great golf right now. What do you kind of tribute that to? Have you found something that's really dialed in for you?**

**STEVE FLESCH:** I don't know if I've really found something, I'm just trying to play patient golf. I know it's boring, but this course kind of suits that style of play. Been hitting it well and obviously putting it well and that usually will equate to shooting some good scores.

**Q. If I was a betting man, I'd bet you the same clubs that were in your bag at Pebble are not the same clubs that are in your bag now; am I right?**

**STEVE FLESCH:** Two of them are different, yep.

**Q. What did we change?**

**STEVE FLESCH:** 3-wood's different and my hybrid's different, but the rest of them are all the same.

**Q. Why did we switch?**

**STEVE FLESCH:** Because they can always be better. Every club in my bag's on waivers. Just because I won last week didn't mean they were all performing well. I hit a couple good shots at the right time to get the win, but I get where guys love to keep the same clubs in their bag. Doesn't bother me, I'll switch three days in a row. If I think that's the way I've got to go, that's what I'm going to do. I don't look back. I've made some mistakes in the past and probably shouldn't have switched, but at the same time, I'll go and buy a club if it looks good and I think it's going to work. To me, they're just tools of the trade and if there's a better tool out there that might fit my game better, I'm willing to put it in play.
