



Q. So you get a chance to do something special this week. How do you feel going into this week to have a chance to tie the record?

BERNHARD LANGER: Oh, I feel the same. I don't think about that. I'm trying to play every day and every hole as good as I can and if it happens, it happens. If not, we'll try next time. That's how it goes.

Q. Does it seem like it's been 15 years you've been on this tour?

BERNHARD LANGER: Yeah, in a way it does and in another way it feels like time flew by, so it's weird.

Q. Bernie, last week with the victory, is there a kickstart for you, (inaudible), I assume? Something like that or no? Or is it just plateau? Is it winning as usual?

BERNHARD LANGER: You mean get to Hualalai soon to win another tournament?

Q. Yeah.

BERNHARD LANGER: No, I'm looking forward to getting some time off. I think everybody is, it's been a long season. The holidays are coming up and we all have plans doing this and that and getting some rest. No, I'm definitely ready, ready for that. But then, you know, come January I'll be looking forward to go to Hualalai. It's one of my favorite tournaments and places and I've done well there and it's definitely worth the trip.

Q. All the wins and the money and trophies aside, what is it that keeps bringing you back week to week?

BERNHARD LANGER: It's the love of the game and competing at the highest level with the best players my age.

Q. Never gets old teeing it up?

BERNHARD LANGER: Very seldom. No, it doesn't.

Q. Did you ever envision when you were 20 years old --

BERNHARD LANGER: I had no -- no, I was green behind my ears. I had no clue what I was getting myself into. I was just trying to make a living and in those days it was difficult,

there wasn't any money around. And I came from Germany where there was nobody to compare myself with. I was the only guy on Tour. The whole thing was very awkward and I really didn't know what was ahead of me. Never dreamt of still playing golf at age 65 and living in America playing the American -- the PGA TOUR and all that kind of stuff, now the PGA Tour Champions. No, that was not even on my radar screen.

Q. Are you going skiing this year?

BERNHARD LANGER: Probably not. I wish I was. Got to get a house, you know. Buy a house, sell a house, all that kind of stuff.

Q. Are you moving?

BERNHARD LANGER: Yeah, yeah, forced to. We already sold ours.
