CALLUM TARREN (-17)



Q. How do you assess what was the emotion of the day and how it felt out there and what was clicking?

CALLUM TARREN: Yeah, I felt super comfortable all day. Got off to a real hot start, 3 under through five, I think. Just kept hitting greens, giving myself chances all day. I think I missed one green, which was the third hole.

Yeah, I felt pretty cool out there. Obviously I knew where I was, but I just kept trying to hit good shots, hit it in the fairway, hit it on the green and give myself chances.

Q. Is that -- did you learn anything about yourself today? Like what was being in the mix and in contention and those feelings on the back nine?

CALLUM TARREN: Yeah, I've drawn from a few experiences in the past, but for some reason today I just felt super chilled and, like you said, nothing to lose but everything to gain. It's such a tight leaderboard, so you needed to shoot 5 or 6 under from my position to even have a chance. So that was the game plan going out, just make some birdies and see what happens.

Q. Is it crazy thinking how much different, last time this year you had missed every cut in the fall and no points and now you're in this spot. Just how crazy the scene here is compared to last year?

CALLUM TARREN: Yeah, my caddie even said that. He said halfway around that back nine, he said this time last year you had zero points, didn't make a cut.

Yeah, I've kind of just got more comfortable out here and obviously that back end of the season last season to keep my card was incredible. So drawing off that experience. And like you said, I feel as though I have a chance. Well, if I play like I did this week, I'll have many more chances to win.

Q. What's it mean to you just to have a chance to win on the PGA TOUR?

CALLUM TARREN: Oh, it's massive, absolutely massive. Like you said, it's the best golf tour in the world and I love playing out here and hopefully I'm out here for a long time.
