KEVIN KISNER (+7)

Q. So take us through that shot and when was the last time before today that you had one?

KEVIN KISNER: On Tour was New Orleans three or four years ago in the team event with Scott Brown.

I was putting probably the worst of my career today so I decided just to make it from 189 yards, but it was a lot easier on par 3s because you got to hit a clean golf ball.

Q. So what was the club from 189?

KEVIN KISNER: 6-iron, yeah. Tommy said it was in from the moment I hit it.

Q. And how would you describe the round overall?

KEVIN KISNER: Played horrible, putted awful, missed probably seven putts inside of six feet. Tough day when the wind's blowing and a lot of mud on the golf balls in the fairways.

Q. What was the worst one you got today?

KEVIN KISNER: No. 4. Had a 4-iron in with mud all on the left side with wind off the left and lost ball left of the green. Pretty hard to aim it in the middle of that. But the leaders aren't having any problems, so wasn't too hard for everyone.

Q. Were you surprised the didn't (inaudible)?

KEVIN KISNER: Absolutely shocked, yeah.

Q. Would you say (inaudible)?

KEVIN KISNER: We called 'em out there like four times to look at our balls, just to show.

Q. How many hole-in-ones do you have in your career?

KEVIN KISNER: On Tour?

Q. Yeah.

KEVIN KISNER: Just two.



Q. How many total?

KEVIN KISNER: I have no idea.

Q. You've lost track you've had so many?

KEVIN KISNER: Yeah, I mean, I've been playing for 30 years, 35 years. I don't really remember.

Q. And Kevin, before we let you go, we've got about --

KEVIN KISNER: For you, Jack, 35 minutes. I'm headed straight to the house, bring some beer.

Q. And a prediction on the game?

KEVIN KISNER: Yeah, we're going to smoke 'em 42-14, something like that.
