## **CAMERON YOUNG (-12)**

## Q. Cameron, how would you kind of assess the day?

**CAMERON YOUNG:** I think I played much better today actually than I had the last few days. Yeah, I didn't make quite as many putts as yesterday, but I think overall I actually played the best probably today of any day.

Q. Did you feel like -- I know you said you haven't driven the ball as well as you'd have liked. Did you feel like you drove the ball better today?

**CAMERON YOUNG:** Much better today. I hit a couple I didn't like, but for the most part I had a lot more control over kind of just the shapes with the driver and I definitely hit more fairways today as well.

Q. When you get to kind of sit back and reflect on 2022 as a year, what's going to be kind of the overall kind of theme of your reflection, what you're going to kind of look at as what was so great from the year?

**CAMERON YOUNG:** I think the same thing was said, just the opportunities that I've given myself with my play the last year moving forward. They kind of kept -- I kept giving myself more and more opportunities for last year, but I think finishing up the season, making it to East Lake, all that, I set myself up going forward really nicely. But I feel like people have been asking me that question since like August, so I'm kind of moving forward at this point.

Q. Last question from me, what's the biggest thing you've learned this year about yourself?

**CAMERON YOUNG:** I don't know, I don't know. I think just golf-wise anyway, just that I can compete out here because you kind of never know until you do. I think a lot of us believe that we can, but that's different than having some proof. So I think just the more I'm out here, golf-wise, just the fact that I know I can compete and I have some evidence to back that up.

Q. Are you willing to travel to play DP World Tour next year?

**CAMERON YOUNG:** I probably won't play much on the DP World Tour next year, no. I'll play predominantly the PGA TOUR. We have to play 21 events, I think, or 20 events, something like that. I won't have time to play elsewhere.

Q. Because there is alliance between DP World Tour and PGA TOUR, do you think we need to have more PGA TOUR players playing in Europe?



**CAMERON YOUNG:** Honestly, I have no idea. I know that they have a strong relationship and that it's a nice opportunity to get to play some in Europe. But honestly, I don't know if we should have more guys playing or not.
