

ROUND 4 INTERVIEW
January 28, 2023



KEEGAN BRADLEY (-11)

Q. Keegan, so bogey-free 66 in the final round at this course and this tournament. Just thoughts on the day and getting yourself into contention?

KEEGAN BRADLEY: Yeah, that was so fun. I love this course, I love coming here. Like when I think of the PGA TOUR, I think of Torrey Pines. My first time I saw Tiger I was on that putting green and I just love this tournament.

Man, that was close.

Q. At what point in the round did you feel like, OK, there's a legitimate shot here?

KEEGAN BRADLEY: When I chipped in on 13 I was trying to not look at leaderboards because I figured I was too far back to really push, you know. I mean, you can't push on this course, so I didn't want to feel like I had to push. Then when I chipped in there and I hit it to a couple feet on 14, I thought I'm ahead of these guys, I can post something and who knows.

Q. And then you've won already this season and you're continuing to stack up good finishes. What do you attribute that to as you kind of look at this past three or four months I guess holistically?

KEEGAN BRADLEY: I've got great coaches, Darren May, Phil Kenyon and I've got an unbelievable caddie, Scottie Vail. He called me off of an iron on 14 that took a lot of guts because I was about to pull the trigger and he called me off. The wind he thought had switched and I went to a different club and hit it to a foot. I've got good people around here, I'm in a good place and I look to continue to do this the rest of the year.

Q. And then just moving forward, what's your schedule looking like and how do you continue to build off this good momentum?

KEEGAN BRADLEY: I'm playing Phoenix and Riviera coming up. So again, the west coast feels like big week after big week. It's another couple courses that I love to play. We got a lot of big events on the PGA TOUR this year and I'm excited to be playing them.

Q. Lastly, the second shot on 18, what were you seeing there? Take us through that. And then the bunker shot, what you were trying to do there?

KEEGAN BRADLEY: I had an awkward number into 18 and I tried to kind of float a shot in there. I was trying for 3, I thought I might need to make 3 and I just -- the one shot I mis-hit

all day. And I was trying to bank the bunker shot down and I missed that by maybe a foot. Then I hit a good putt that didn't go in.
