

**PAUL HALEY II ( -10)**

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**Q. Great round today, bogey-free 6-under 66. Just a few comments about what kind of clicked for you?**

**PAUL HALEY II:** Finally been putting better. I worked on it really hard the last three days a couple hours a day. I've been hitting the ball pretty good all year and since I guess the Sony Open I just kind of had -- I've been three-putting a bunch, missing a lot of short putts, but that's kind of the only thing that hasn't been clicking for me. Generally that's like the best part of my game, so that's really been the only difference. Drove it good, obviously doing everything pretty good and just seeing some putts go in has been the difference.

**Q. Has it been a test of patience or are you typically pretty good when you get frustrated with something you know you're good at that just isn't working that's finally come around?**

**PAUL HALEY II:** It's been frustrating just because it's like one day I'll putt good and the next day I won't make anything. This is the first time in a while where I've had two really good days in a row of good putting. I've been working really hard on my speed and trying to get out of, I guess, the result of the putt and if I'm around the hole, I'm counting that it's a win so far. And luckily I've made a bunch of putts so far, so it's been good.

**Q. And final question, just the conditions. I know you're making your second start here, the first in like 10 years. The conditions, is the course something that sets up well for your game?**

**PAUL HALEY II:** It does. I'm from Dallas and my course also has a lot of crosswinds and there's a lot of crosswinds out here, so I feel comfortable out there. Kind of know what shots to play. I hit the ball pretty low anyways, so a solid 15- to 20-mile-an-hour wind is not really going to affect my ball maybe as much as some other guys that hit it really high. It's been not as big of an adjustment for me as maybe some of the other guys.
