TYRRELL HATTON (-12)



Q. How would you kind of characterize the day, Tyrrell?

TYRRELL HATTON: I mean, naturally disappointed only in the sense of like wanting to do better. Wanted to get off to a faster start and try and add some pressure in a way. But, I mean, I feel like I was just, I was struggling. I didn't feel very comfortable with my swing. It's hard when you're trying to make birdies, it's not the easiest of golf courses, and yeah, I just found today a bit of a struggle. Although if you said at the start of the week tied third finish, then sure, you probably would have been happy, but yeah, just naturally want to do better.

Q. You seemingly had a pretty good run in the designated events. Coincidence or do they bring out something? Do you enjoy the bigger feel of these tournaments?

TYRRELL HATTON: I mean, I don't treat them any differently, so I don't know why this year I've done so far nicely in the elevated events. It's the same as every tournament that we go to, I'm just out there trying my best to shoot as low a score as we possibly can. Yeah, I mean, there's nothing I can -- I don't prep any different or anything like that, so I don't know why we seem to have done nicely so far this year.

Q. What do you make of Wyndham? He hasn't really been in this position much, hasn't -- obviously his first win, to sort of do it at this place and with Xander playing with him?

TYRRELL HATTON: Yeah, I mean, it's an extremely impressive weekend. I thought 8 under, those two yesterday shooting 8 under and 7 under as a group, yesterday was hard, the wind was all over the place and those guys shooting those scores was extremely impressive. Was it a two-shot lead he had today?

Q. Yeah.

TYRRELL HATTON: To go and put that round together to finish at 20 or 19 under is a fantastic effort. Yeah, he deserves to be holding that trophy.

Q. You like where your game is heading into the PGA?

TYRRELL HATTON: Yes and no. I mean, I felt so uncomfortable over the ball this weekend, I literally, I didn't feel like I could hit a good shot. I stood over tee shots today feeling like I was going to snap hook. For me naturally, I fade the ball, so it's not a nice feeling. So to get round in the score that I did today considering how uncomfortable I felt, I'll take that. Hopefully feel more comfortable over the ball next week in Dallas.
