

Q. Taylor, how would you kind of characterize that round today?

TAYLOR MOORE: Yeah, just solid. As I was saying a second ago, one bogey on the card and really just kept the ball in front of me. Drove it better on the back nine, hit some fairways, which allows you to really play pretty solid out here and be able to kind of attack when you have a good number but hit the fat part of the green, give yourself some space and did a good job of that coming in.

Q. You mentioned some of those par saves on the front. How big are those to maybe keep the round going until you can maybe hit the ball a little better?

TAYLOR MOORE: Just momentum, right? Just did a really good job of giving myself some uphill right-to-lefters and five-, six-footers and had some confident rolls and be able to see them go in, definitely got me in a good place early.

Q. When you were talking to PGA TOUR Radio, the win at Valspar, then obviously RBC Heritage and a good team event, where has your confidence gone after that win?

TAYLOR MOORE: I think anytime you win out here it's just a little validation to yourself that not only can you compete out here, but you can hoist a trophy. Yeah, just carrying over that momentum from Valspar and some good play early in the season and it's definitely nice to see it's still going.

Q. Do you feel that you're doing anything differently in your game that's improved since then or is that inner confidence that's maybe coming out a little bit more?

TAYLOR MOORE: Nothing really in my game. Physically I'm just really doing the same things. Josh Gregory and I, my coach, really just talk about staying boring and just doing what we do, sticking to our plan and doing the little stuff, little things that we do day in and day out. So physically nothing's really changed, yeah, but just a little bit of confidence from that win for sure.

Q. How hard is that to do the boring things, especially when you're in contention and things start to heat up around you?

TAYLOR MOORE: Yeah, harder than people probably realize, but it's kind of what's made me me and really just sticking to it and it's definitely nice to see that stuff pay off.

Q. It's your first time playing Quail Hollow. What did you like about the course?



TAYLOR MOORE: It's just got a really cool feel. It's an awesome place, it's a really fun layout. I think there's a really good balance of hard challenging holes where if you hit two really good shots you get rewarded and also the balance of some fun drivable holes, kind of the one on the front and obviously the one on the back. Yeah, just really a fun golf course and always like places that really reward you for hitting quality golf shots.
