## **Q.** Tommy, what was the biggest difference between Thursday and Friday's rounds?

I drove the ball so much better today, so I actually felt like I was giving myself a good look at it and a good chance. Two or three chances that I missed, holed a couple of nice putts and well made a good up-and-down on the last hole. I think it seems to have played trickier today and I'm not sure why because pins felt like they were OK, like nothing felt like they were really standing out, like they were tricked up or anything like that or tucked away. It's just a tough golf course.

# Q. Curious, what's the ribbon for on your hat today?

TOMMY FLEETWOOD: Lance, the caddie. I think everybody's wearing that in respect.

## Q. Whose idea was that to start that?

**TOMMY FLEETWOOD:** Generally somebody always sets it up when someone's passed and it's just something respectful for the guys who have been out here and they were just there on the first tee.

## Q. Did you know Lance at all?

**TOMMY FLEETWOOD:** I met him once or twice. I actually didn't know him as well as a lot of the other guys and I didn't have the opportunity to spend that much time with him, but very cool guy and a great story and obviously loved the game.
