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**Q. Tommy, a little bit of kind of a rocky start, kind of came back a little bit. Just your overall assessment of the day?**

**TOMMY FLEETWOOD:** Yeah, sort of a ropey start, missed that short one on 3 really and then I had a good chance on 4. On a tricky day I gave a couple of shots away, which is never good, but came out really well and played great really. Happy with the day. Felt like I did a lot of good things and yeah, overall it's been a great week. You should never look at these weeks as a negative.

**Q. Does that show after a little bit of a rocky start how good your game is right now, to be able to come back and play the way you did, get it under par?**

**TOMMY FLEETWOOD:** I think so. Today was so, so difficult, and again, if you get right up there on a leaderboard, you need to shoot a good round on a really difficult day and anything under par today is still very, very good golf, so I'm pleased with that.

Yeah, there were things I could look at that I would obviously love to improve and pretty much everybody is like that except almost one person every week. Yeah, it was great. The course, I said at the start of the week, I kind of struggled in the past and then I played great this week. So it was nice to play well around there and have some good positive energy.

**Q. Off this coming week and then the PGA?**

**TOMMY FLEETWOOD:** Yeah, off this week, PGA and Colonial, yeah.

**Q. Game's obviously in great form. What do you feel like you maybe need to just touch up a little bit before heading to Rochester?**

**TOMMY FLEETWOOD:** I just think stay ready, make sure I'm fresh coming into the week. Yeah, just be ready to play and prepare well when we get there.

Overall so far this year my game is trending so well, and I have to make sure that I keep reminding myself of that and sort of get out there and let it happen. But there's so many good things that I think just get to a major prepare well, make sure you're fresh not just Thursday, but hopefully come Sunday and we'll be in contention again.
