Q. Brett, 8-under, bogey-free round today. Just what are your takeaways from Round 2 and kind of mindset going into tomorrow?

BRETT QUIGLEY: I knew, I saw when I made the turn the scores were pretty low, then I saw Ernie made a couple more birdies and got it to 12. I knew I needed to keep the pedal down and keep making birdies. Fortunately, I did, finished with four. It's nice. And then Corey's always nice in helping me smile.

Q. That was a good strong finish, those last four holes. Did you find anything going into there, because it seemed like it was, you know --

BRETT QUIGLEY: The whole back nine I played well, I think I hit every green or had some good putts at it. If you get going out here you feel like you can make a bunch, and it's sometimes not easy not to press, so I tried to just stay patient. Fortunately made the one on 15, two-putt 16, had a nice shot on 17, all of a sudden there was four in a row. So it was a nice finish, hopefully somewhere near Ernie.

Q. With the weather coming tomorrow it can be a long day. Is patience the keyword?

BRETT QUIGLEY: Birdies, lots of 'em. I mean, typically it will probably be 17 under. I know you've still got to play a great round tomorrow and not let up.

Q. The weather doesn't affect you?

BRETT QUIGLEY: No, not at all. I just hope we get it in, that's our goal and that's why I think we're going to probably go a little early tomorrow and try to get them all in.
