COLIN FEATHERSTONE (-8)

Q. Colin, first round, career low for you on the Korn Ferry Tour. How are you feeling?

COLIN FEATHERSTONE: Feeling good. Feeling tired, it's been a long day. I think I started my warmup 12 hours ago.

Q. Obviously there was a four- or five-hour delay there in the middle. What did you do to kind of kill time?

COLIN FEATHERSTONE: I ate, I played some pinball and then I actually went in the car for a little bit and took a nap for about 30 minutes. I think I watched an episode of a Game of Thrones. At that point we were getting close to going back out. It was clearing up, so I could tell we might be moving pretty soon. Yeah, just wasted time the best I could.

Q. Big gap there in the middle of the day, but when you were on the course, what was working for you to get that 63?

COLIN FEATHERSTONE: Yeah, I hit it well off the tee, kind of put myself in position to come into the greens and had some good looks, hit some close. Just managed my way around the course pretty well.

Q. First year on the Korn Ferry Tour. I guess up to this point how are you feeling so far about the season and your game?

COLIN FEATHERSTONE: Feeling good about it. Some good, some bad, but that's kind of how a long season goes. You have some good finishes and some bad. Game's starting to come around so I feel like I'm in a good spot.

Q. How much of a distraction is that with a delay of that length when you're playing well, just wanting to get back out and get it going but can't?

COLIN FEATHERSTONE: Yeah, especially when it's a delay like that when you don't know, you're just getting updates every 30 minutes. So kind of just try to stay in it but also, I mean, you can't focus for that long so I kind of like try to zone out as well as I can and do other things. Then when they tell us to go, we go.

Q. Is that the longest delay you think you've ever been in?



COLIN FEATHERSTONE: No, I think Huntsville this year was probably the longest delay I've ever been in, but I was lucky that week I was an afternoon tee time, so I was just hanging out at home or at the host house the whole time. That was definitely the longest delay.

Q. What was the difference in course conditions between the morning and the afternoon?

COLIN FEATHERSTONE: Just a little softer, yeah. Weren't getting quite as much run-out on the tee shots, and then coming into the greens they were a little softer. But honestly, the course held up pretty well with all the rain we got.

Q. Where did your pinball score hold up this afternoon?

COLIN FEATHERSTONE: Oh, I don't remember. I didn't scare the high score, that's for sure.
